Description:

Subject to prevailing weather and fire ground conditions the proposed prescribed burn is expected to commence on **Tuesday 08 May 2018** and take at least 3 - 5 days to implement. Smoke will be visible from the surrounding rural residential areas near Napoleon Reef, Walang, Yetholme, Kirkconnell and Sunny Corner and may persist in the local area for up to a week.

The prescribed burn is being conducted to generally maintain the floristic and structural diversity of vegetation communities in an area currently subject to an adverse (long unburnt) fire regime. The activity is expected to enhance the conservation and biodiversity values within the nature reserve and reduce the overall fuel hazard in this area.
