Dementia Awareness Week/dementia friendly community - Kas indicated her disappointment that Dementia Week wasn't celebrated or acknowledged this year. A Dementia Alliance of community members to be developed to ensure it doesn't slip through again next year.

Old peoples Home for 4 year olds - Kas would like to see the benefits of intergenerational activities expanded to local nursing homes.

Australia Day- Council to actively seek nominations for all categories, especially the youth category as it is notoriously hard to find nominees.

Opera: Opera Australia can include Lithgow on its winter tour in September 2020. Possible venues include Union theatre and Civic Ballroom. Gaye to investigate venues with Matthew. Cost will be \$16,000 to be offset by ticket sales which is very reasonable for such a prestigious event which will bring many people to Lithgow.
