Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and associated social distancing requirements, Council is regretfully unable to offer the usual 'in-house' Primary School Waste Education Program in 2020.

2020 is turning out to be a particularly tough year for families and students in the Lithgow Area due to the combined impact of the bushfires over the summer months and the COVID-19 pandemic.

Many primary school students will be doing their school work from home in Term 2. In place of the in-house waste education workshops provided in previous years, Council is offering all primary school students the option to participate in the 'We are Waste Wise' Primary School Art Competition, with great prizes to be won (see information flyer on the next page for details).

The theme for the competition is 'Our Place...Our Future'. Students are encouraged to draw a picture about what they think is special about their village or their local environment. The competition task has been designed to align with the Australian National Curriculum areas listed below:



### Terms and Conditions

- 1. The 'We Are Waste Wise' Primary School Art Competition is open from Term 2 (28 April 2020) and entries must be submitted by the end of Term 2 (3 July 2020)
- 2. All entries must be hand drawn on A4-sized paper (no digitally created artworks will be accepted)
- 3. All entries must be original artwork- making an exact copy of any pre-existing image is not acceptable, whether visually or by tracing. Colouring in an outline printed or drawn by someone else or having someone else contribute to the artwork is also not acceptable
- 4. Only one entry per student will be accepted
- 5. Only one student per entry is permitted i.e. students cannot submit a joint entry
- 6. The theme of the competition is 'Our Place...Our Future'- drawings are to be based around what is special about 'our place'. Schools may wish to pick a theme that links to their village/ place, or provide creative freedom to students in this regard.
- 7. The theme may also include how managing waste helps to look after 'Our Place', but this is not essential
- 8. The entry must include the words Our Place or Our Place...Our Future in the artwork
- 9. Entries will be judged by Council staff and decisions are final
- 10. Four prizes will be awarded: Overall Winner; Runner-up; Best Local Landmark/ Landscape; and Encouragement Award (for younger entries)
- 11. Winning prize is to the value of \$50 and all other prizes (three) are \$30 value each
- 12. Entries can be submitted by scanning or photographing artwork and emailing to Council's waste education partner, EnviroCom, on <a href="mailto:lithgow.outreach@envirocom.au">lithgow.outreach@envirocom.au</a> Be sure to include your name, school and class

- 14. The winning entry will be selected two weeks after the closing date
- 15. By entering this competition parents and teachers consent to have the children's names and their artworks to appear online and at the exhibition
- 16. Council gains the right to use the winning artworks, which may include, but is not limited to, exhibition, use in the development of signage, social media posts and print materials
- 17. Council reserves the right to crop and/ or correct artwork for hanging or use and to ensure consistency of appearance
