- Nominees must be Australian citizens and reside in the Lithgow Local Government Area at the time of nomination.
- Unsuccessful nominees may be re-nominated in subsequent years. Self nominations will not be accepted.
- Awards will not be granted posthumously.
- The minimum age for the NSW Local Citizen of the Year Awards is 16 years on 26 January 2023.
- Nominees for Young Volunteer of the Year and Young Citizen of the Year Award must be aged 16 to 25 years on 26 January 2023.
- Sitting state and federal politicians and current vice-regal officers are not eligible. Retired politicians and officers will only be considered for work beyond their official duties.
- A person cannot receive a second award in the same award category, but can be considered for recognition in a separate category in following years eg. Young Volunteer of the Year and Open Citizen of the Year Award.
