

I have been, and still am involved in the South Bowenfels Rural Fire Service, and am currently, and have been, for a number of years, the President/Secretary of the Brigade. I was involved in the Lithgow Business Association, and held the positions of Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer, during this time. I am also a member of the Chamber of Commerce and an active member of the Business Networking Group. I have been a business owner for the past 9 years, as well as being involved in my parents businesses prior to this.

As an active member of the community, I am aware of the various needs of the community groups, such as their Financial Assistance requirements and the value of acknowledging, and recognising, local citizens and citizenship awards. These include the naming of parks, roads or Council Assets – e.g. The Jim Robson Memorial Pool and Kiddle Park, and recognition of such at the annual Australia Day Awards Ceremony.

I feel that projects such as The Blast Furnace upgrade and the Adventure Playground are important projects for Lithgow. I believe I have a great deal to offer both Council and the community in helping to bring these, and other projects to fruition.

Whilst involved with the Lithgow Business Association, I was part of the Committee involved in the preparation and presentation of Celebrate Lithgow. I have actively attended the information sessions for Lithgow Halloween, and I believe that the business people should be involved in helping with the running of these events. Events such as these increase community pride as well as encourage visitors to our region.

I currently “keep an eye on” my next door neighbour, who is frail and uses a walker, as well as assisting frail and disabled clients in my business. I also looked after my parents prior to their passing. As a result of this, I have had first hand experience in the needs of people who are aged or have disabilities.

I am aware that Council has to finalise the Disability Access Inclusion Plan by the end of the year. I believe that this plan is an important plan, as Lithgow currently has an aging population, and we need to be catering for the projected influx of retirees who find they are able to afford to retire in Lithgow and still live a comfortable lifestyle. This could give Lithgow a point of difference to other areas in that, we are catering for/and could become known as, being accessible friendly for anyone with a disability, thus encouraging visitors or potential new residents to our LGA.

Under the previous model of the Disability Access Committee I was a community representative from Dec 2015 to the recent amalgamation. During this time I provided valuable support to this group through my proactive commitment to meetings, research and planning, agenda item feedback and support of the transport submission.

As an overview currently I work for with Ability Links (Uniting) as a Linker, and support people with a disability aged 9-64 years and their families / carers. This program supports individual goals and aspirations working towards connectedness to the community. Due to the inclusion of the Disability Access Committee into the Community Development Committee it is important to ensure that the needs of people with a disability are represented bringing forward the concerns and issues of accessibility to Lithgow City Council.

Additionally I am a person with a disability as I have Multiple Sclerosis – relapsing remitting at this stage. This is a progressive neurological illness and as such I have developed mobility and balance issues, which have, heightened my awareness that accessibility is paramount for social inclusion and have experienced the limitations within our local community.

Throughout my employment / volunteer history I have worked in community service industries which has seen a diverse range of support for many local people in our community. I wish to continue this proactive community involvement allowing people with disability to have a voice and access every opportunity they should choose within the local area.

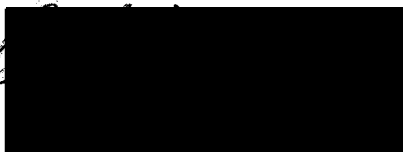
