- All artworks must demonstrate the re-use and recycling of waste.
- No new materials unless structurally required.
- Coordinators will notify local Waste 2 Art winners.
- Results of the Waste 2 Art Regional Showcase be announced on the NetWaste website.
- All entrants grant permission to publish names, photographs and artworks.
- Judges and their immediate families are not eligible to enter.
- The Judges decision is final, no correspondence will be entered into.
- Artworks and copyright remain the property of the entrant.
- An artist's statement will accompany each entry (MAX 300 WORDS)
- Artworks must be safe for public exhibition and labeled with your name and council.
- No packaged artwork to exceed a size of 1 meter in any one direction or a weight of 30kgs.
- All artworks must be exhibition ready. Works to be hung require a hanging system, sculptures must be freestanding. Display instructions are emailed to admin@netwaste.com.au

If selected for the WASTE 2 ART Regional Showcase artworks must be delivered to your local coordinator packed for transport and collected on return from your local coordinator. Contact your local WASTE 2 ART Coordinator for details. The cost and means of transport to your local exhibition are the responsibility of the entrant. If you are a winner at the local exhibition your work will be transported to a Regional Exhibition free of charge once you have packed and taken it to the nominated collection point. The organisers will take all reasonable care in handling and dealing with works submitted, however the organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any of the artworks or materials.
