Meadow Flat Waste Transfer Station

Council acknowledges your complaint submission received on the 9th May 2024 in relation to the Meadow Flat Transfer Station.

We acknowledge the changes implemented at the facility may impact some residents, however these changes were considered necessary to improve the performance and use of the facility. In particular, the placement of recycled concrete blocks ensures effective operation of the security camera to help protect the facility from illegal dumping and misuse.

We appreciate there may be difficulties unloading at the facility, however Council does not support residents standing on their vehicles and unloading directly into the skip bin for safety reasons. The facility is designed for vehicles to unload domestic household waste only and any set-up that allows easy offloading of large quantities of waste can encourage illegal dumping of commercial and construction/demolition waste.

Council understands that some residents may use the facility infrequently for their household waste and therefore be unloading larger quantities. In this scenario we recommend using the Lithgow Resource Recovery Centre at – 68 Geordie Street Lithgow, where 7 days a week you can access an all-weather facility with help offered by site attendants.
