Community Recycling Centre (CRC) Hours

The items below are also accepted at the **Community Recycling Centre (CRC).**

At the CRC, you can drop off the following problem waste items, 7 days a week:

- Batteries car & household
 - Fire extinguishers
- Fluorescent globes
- Gas bottles
- Oils incl. cooking and motor oils
 - Paint & paint-related products
 - Smoke detectors

The above items *never* go into the kerbside bins

The CRC is open from 8am - 4.45pm, 7 days a week

All vehicles must be off the site by 5pm

Please plan your visit to have enough time to unload and leave the site within opening hours.

Public Holidays:

- Closed Good Friday,
- Closed Christmas Day,
- Open on other public holidays.



What can be dropped off at the: Household Chemical CleanOut (HCC)

The following items are **only accepted** at the annual, half-day, HCC:











The chemicals that can only be disposed of at the HCC include:

- Acids and alkalis
- Ammonia-based cleaners
- Chemicals hobby and pool
- Floor care products
- Household cleaners and solvents
- Pesticides and herbicides
- Poisons

What can be dropped off at the: Community Recycling Centre (CRC)

The CRC is open 7 days, 8am-4.45pm

What can I take to a CRC?



- The CRC is a drop-off centre for the problem waste items above. These problem items cannot go into kerbside bins or into landfill.
- NSW residents can drop off problem items at CRCs free of charge.
- The CRC is open at the same time as the RRC, every day except Good Friday and Christmas day.
- Only household quantities of each item will be accepted a maximum of 20 litres or 20 kilograms of each type of waste.
- There is no charge to dispose of accepted items at the CRC.
- Businesses cannot use the CRC and should contact a waste disposal services provider. Visit: <u>https://businessrecycling.com.au/</u>

Using the Household Chemical CleanOut (HCC)

Safely transport chemicals to the HCC

- Never mix chemicals. Dangerous reactions could occur.
- Keep chemicals in the original containers if possible.
- Label and seal containers. If substance is unknown, label the container 'unknown chemical'.
- Prevent leaks during transport by wrapping containers in newspaper, sealing in plastic bags and placing in plastic buckets or trays.
- Keep chemicals away from passengers, for example, by securing the chemicals in the boot of your car.

Who can use the HCC?

- Only residents of the Lithgow LGA can use the HCC.
- Business related and commercial quantities are **not accepted** at the HCC.
