

What can go in your red lid domestic waste bin?



Your red lid bin (red bin) is for general domestic waste.

Your red bin is collected weekly, on the same day as your green bin.

Your red bin is for general domestic rubbish that cannot be reused, recycled or composted including:

✓		Bubble wrap
✓		Clothes, shoes, bags, fabric items, leather items and gloves
✓		Disposable coffee cups and lids
✓		Face masks
✓		Garden hose
✓		Greaseproof paper, baking paper, waxed paper, glad wrap
✓		Meat trays
✓		Nappies and hygiene products
✓		Paper towels, tissues, serviettes
✓		Polystyrene foam and packaging
✓		Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) kits
✓		Soft plastics that can be scrunched

✗ These items must not go in the red bin:

Batteries ✗ (Recycle at Lithgow Solid Waste Facility or Council's administration building)

Electronic appliances or mobile phones ✗ (Recycle at Lithgow Solid Waste Facility or see Council's website for other recycling locations)

Light bulbs or fluorescent tubes ✗ (Recycle at Lithgow Solid Waste Facility or see Council's website for other recycling locations)

Medical waste ✗ (Follow instructions from your chemist or health care provider.)

Liquids or hazardous waste ✗ (Take paint, oils, garden/pool chemicals, cleaners, acids, bleaches, flammable items, smoke detectors, gas cylinders to the *Community Recycling Centre* or *Household Chemical Cleanout*)
