Proposal: Affix Bronze Name Plaques of all residents 1938 -1954 (56) to Glen Davis Community Hall.

Background: I was given Leonie Knapman's book 'Glen Davis, A Shale Oil Ghost Town and it's People 1938-1954 and attended her lecture at the Lithgow Library on 11th October of this year 2018.

On Facebook not long after, there was a posting that the coming October long weekend was the 80th anniversary of the foundation of Glen Davis. Being that Glen Davis is my home town, I went.

Leonie's book, the lecture and George Wilson's historical walking tour on the Sunday has inspired me to this proposal.

Though there is a lot of historical data, my purpose is to acknowledge those names that may not have got a mention. In the fullness of time will all be forgotten if they have not been recorded in paper or photo form, that is in private memories. Just in the 64 years since close the former residents and their descendants are probably scattered to the winds.

The attached is the result of my further enquires, offering to all former residents of this period *at their own cost*, to purchase a bronze nameplate (fig 1 & 2), send to Glen Davis and as a fund raiser these plaques will be screwed to the bricks.

My hope is as the years go by, more and more former residents and their descendants would add their family's names, those pioneers who came to Glen Davis for a future only to have it closed down operationally 16 years later.

I have no idea how many may take this up if approved but as the examples of the name plaques attached I would for a start.

On the weekend of the 1st December I will be attending the annual Railway Christmas party and very much would like to fix an appointment for Friday 30th November with Mr Faulkner, at 2 pm after I arrive from Lake Cathie at about midday.

If we can have this appointment some of my discussion points would be;

1. Permission and support from both the Council and the Committee.
2. Possible official ceremony at Glen Davis at their annual Long weekend reunion.
3. Platforms of advertising.
4. If approved, where the receival point would be. (Delivery is included in cost of plaque I was told)
5. How would monies and to whom for affixing to Community Hall wall. This is for accountability and transparency since most would be postal and may be spasmodic.
6. In the interest of keeping the entire process for former residents, ownership and participation, yet simple.

Looking forward to feedback and hopefully a living memorial of the names of all those who passed through Glen Davis.

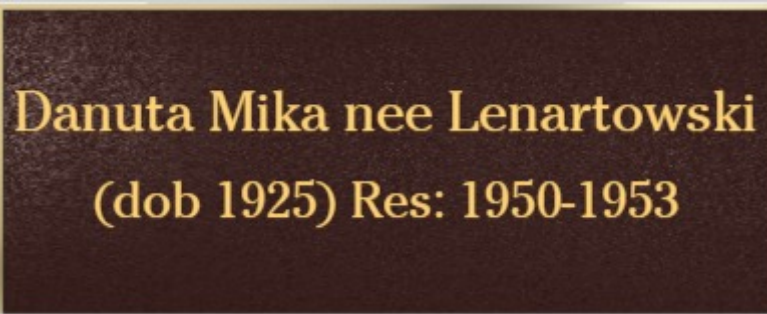
