Mayoral Minute – Congratulations and Follow-up

On 6 May 2025, the Mayor wrote to congratulate you on your re-election as the independent member for Calare.

At the 26 May 2025 Ordinary Meeting, the Mayor put a Mayoral Minute to the Council recommending that Lithgow City Council officially congratulate you on your re-election, and to note that we look forward to working with you on matters that benefit the residents of the Lithgow Local Government Area.

I have copied the Council's resolution on the Mayoral Minute below. The resolution refers to your letter to the Mayor of 24 March 2025 (Ref SB AG05618) which states your commitment to securing \$2 million for the Main Street footpath project by any means possible and working with Council to obtain it.

The resolution also refers to your public stand on wind farms.

- 1. Officially congratulate The Hon Andrew Robert Gee on his re-election to the seat of Calare at the 2025 federal election, and that we look forward to working with him on matters that benefit the residents of the Lithgow Local Government Area.*
- 2. Follow up on Andrew Gee's letter regarding his commitment to advocate to reinstate the \$2 million grant funding for the upgrade to the Main Street Lithgow footpath.*
- 3. Request Andrew Gee continue his advocacy against wind farms as committed in his election campaign.*
