This is a proposal to develop a walking track from the Historic Hartley School down to the Hartley Historic site. It will represent a further opportunity for recreational walking by valley residents and will ultimately represent an element in the Great Western Walk a walk being developed between Emu Ford and Bathurst essentially along the line of Cox's 1815 road. **What are the aims of the request/project?**

To provide a walking track from the Historic Hartley school down the north side of the highway and under the highway bridge to the Hartley Historic Site.

**How will your request/project assist members of the Community?**

It will provide an element in the oft heard call for more walking tracks in the valley and will ultimately represent a section in a greater walk as outlined in the attached.

**What outcomes and benefits will your project have for the community?** Project will build on existing infrastructure enjoyed in the valley to provide a further healthy lifestyle opportunity.

**Demonstrate how your project promotes community development and participation by connecting people, increased opportunity and building community capacity.**

This proposed walking track will ultimately provide an element of the great Western Walk a walking track from Emu Ford to Bathurst largely along the line of William Cox's historic 1813 road to Bathurst. Originally proposed with a first stage of emu Ford to Mt York this extension was proposed to incorporate a Hartley Valley section in the first stage of the GWW project as the second stage may take sometime to come to fruition. In the meantime this first stage development of the walk from Mt York down the Cox's Road walking track and across the Valley via Mid Hartley road (the same line as Cox's 1813 Road) to the Historic Hartley School and down to the Hartley Historic Site via the track proposed herein will provide a self contained element of the greater walk that can be promoted independently as a Mt Victoria to Hartley Historic Site walking track for car and train travelling tourists (train in via Mt Vic and out via Lithgow for Sydney based tourists).

The Historic Hartley School site to Hartley Historic Site element of the track will constitute an element that will appeal to the many calls made by residents for the development of walking and bike tracks in the valley.

**What community consultation has confirmed the need for this program?**

Comprehensive community survey conducted in 2016 identified walking path and cycle tracks to various aprt of the district as a need to satisfy community lifestyle aspirations.
