Please note registrations close 12pm on the Thursday before the Clean-Up date.

- Clean-ups are operated on a service by registration basis.
- Register for a green waste clean-up by **12pm** on the **Thursday** prior to the clean-up date.
- After registering, on the Sunday prior to the clean-up date, place the material at the kerbside where your garbage bin is collected .
- Material left for collection will be removed during the week commencing on the collection date.
- Garden prunings are to be no longer than 2 metres, no thicker than 200mm, and tied in bundles using string or rope made of natural fibres that does not contain plastic.
- Each bundle of green waste should be no heavier than 16 kilograms.
- A maximum of 1 cubic metre (4 wheelie bins) per collection.
- Bagged lawn clippings and leaves are no longer collected due to plastic contamination. Lawn clippings and leaves can be composted at home, placed in your green 'FOGO' bin or delivered to the Lithgow Solid Waste Facility.
- The Contractor and the Council reserve the right to refuse any item they deem unacceptable.



## Please note:

- No bagged grass clippings or leaves
- Bundles to be no heavier than 16 kg
- Branches maximum 2m in length and 200mm in width
- Use string or rope made of natural fibres to tie bundles together
