Local Sport Defibrillator Grant Program now opened. Applications close at 5pm Monday 12th April 2021.

Who is eligible to apply?

- Incorporated, not-for-profit sports and recreational clubs or other incorporated organisations in NSW that are sport or recreation related
- State or national sporting organisations on behalf of member clubs located in NSW
- Licensed sporting clubs, providing that the project directly benefits sporting activities
- Sport clubs associated with a school, church or university providing they are an incorporated not for profit club in their own right
- Councils, and sport and recreational facilities owners on behalf of sport and recreational clubs
- Service clubs such as Rotary, CWA and Lions, on behalf of sports clubs

Update on Grant Funding Projects

D Anderson advised that committee that the irrigation for field 2 and 3 at Tony Luchetti is installed with staff completing the general maintenance of filling trenches, leveling and re seeding the area. It was noted that the project was delayed due to confirmation of grant funding from the government.

The committee were advised that Council were also successful for further funding to upgrade the change room facilities within the Ashley Grandstand at Tony Luchetti with works expected to commence next week after some initial safe testing is complete.

It was also advised that Council contractor will be commencing the installation of Irrigation at Conran and Marjorie Jackson Oval (Paul Houghton Field) from 26th October. It was noted that Conran Oval will not be available for the season.

The committees were also advised that safety repair works are occurring at Watsford Oval on the cricket pitch to make it safe for users.

Associations General Business

M Wren asked the possibility to meet and discuss the relocation of some cricket pitches at Marjorie Jackson and Glanmire to make them more accessible / usable in future seasons. D Whitty suggested that discussion was had previously to remove old nets and move cricket wicket 2 closer to tennis courts this would remove the issue of use of Glanmire 3.

A Magus advised that committee that the lawns at the croquet club are not ready for play but grateful for the Lithgow Bowling Club assisting with the use of their bowling greens for play.

S Morris advised that the junior rugby league season is over for the year, even though it was a shorten season and restrictions in place it went well. It was also noted that the mini league presentation is occurring this Friday at the Tony Luchetti Sportsground.

L Kearney advised that the Netball Winter competition is also over for the year and noted that it was successful as it could be. It was advised that the summer competition has commenced with 8 teams playing on the outdoor fields.

D Whitty also congratulated the Lithgow Bears on their recent award of the NSW Grassroots Club of the Year and National Club of the Year.

Clr Smith also called upon sporting groups to monitor the cleanliness of the sporting facilities and that any issues should be raised with Council by way of calling or emailing.
