# Briefly describe your request/project. If required, attach additional details.

We are trying to make the Old Hartley School and Community Hall more usable to the wider community. The buildings and grounds are hired out to community members for family functions, community events and charity events.

To make the facilities more usable we would like to extend the small shelter shed and install a built in BBQ that can then be used at the varies functions. Currently when people use the facilities there is a small domestic BBQ that needs repairs and would not be able to be used for larger groups. By building the BBQ into the shelter it will be able to be used in all weather conditions and will be protected for the elements. We will also be able to have some food preparation area built in next to the BBQ.

The current shelter has small sandpit next to it, we would like to remove the sandpit and extend the shelter for the BBQ.

By having a built in BBQ there is less chance of damage and theft. The BBQ is larger than personal BBQs and would assist with trying to attract more people from the community to use the facilities. For safety when the facilities are not being used the gas bottles would be stored safely away.

#### What are the aims of the request/project?

As part of our upgrade project to freshen up and repair the Old Hartley School and Community Hall we urgently need to make repairs to the old shelter shed. By enlarging this shed and building a BBQ within the shed the venue becomes more usable for the community. It is the Australian way to have barbeques for functions. The enlarge facilities makes the site much more appealing for rental purposes for the community.

This project will make this facility more usable for the greater community by providing better cooking facilities for community events.

# What outcomes and benefits will your project have for the community?

As mentioned, the benefit to the community would is making this facility more usable for community events and would increase the usage of this facility.

The Hartley District Progress Association are regular users of the facilities and host a 'Long Lunch' each year, this project would provide greater benefit and help them in their preparations for this event. Due to COVID-19 we have been unable to meet with the new Committee. Rosemary Barber is a member of our trust and, also a member of the Progress Association and she supports for this project.
