Our Disability Services team is currently operating from the LINC building (located at 1 Padley Street, Lithgow) but will be moving to a new location in the coming weeks. This new location will provide us ample space from which to run several new and exciting programs for our participants with a disability. Our mission is to allow our participants to access a service which not only provides them support but also assists them to develop new skills, interact with others, build friendships and participate in fun and stimulating activities. Although we have access to a minimal amount of supplies and equipment with which to provide such activities, we are writing today to request approval of a grant to purchase much needed additional supplies which will allow us to commence the upgrade of our outdoor area. This project will take much care and thought and would only be made possible with a grant such as the one you are currently offering. This addition to our service would greatly benefit and improve the services we are able to provide our participants and the opportunities they are then able to experience by partaking in such groups and activities.

The aim is to create an outdoor area for our participants with a disability to engage in a wide range of activities whilst on Day Program with our Service.

How will your request/project assist members of the Community?

This will allow skills development, social interaction, mental and physical stimulation and add variety to their daily experiences.

What outcomes and benefits will your project have for the community?

Many families and individuals living with a disability or have a loved one who lives with a disability find it difficult to find and access appropriate services within their physical capacity around the local area. This would allow a wider range of opportunities for people with a disability to meet other people, develop friendships, utilise their skills and further develop skills, interact with others and to have a variety in their daily lives. This project aims to provide much needed outside time for participants yet allow them to feel supported and encouraged to express themselves and try new things.

The benefits this project will produce will include allowing those with a disability a better range of activities in which they can participate where they can spend time outside in a supported and safe environment, have access to animals and the opportunity to learn how to care for animals, will gain the ability to garden and develop an understanding of the way things grow and how to facilitate plant growth. It will also offer the benefit of providing further locations at which local people with a disability can interact with one another and improve their relationships and social skills.
