Junior Nominations

• Nikera Hann (Cricket) - U'13 Country Thunder

Note nomination was received for January 2020 but was held over as agreed to be considered in 2021.

Nikera was selected in the women's U13 Country Thunder Team to play in the State Cup challenge at Wellington in January 2020. Her selection came about after a terrific Country Championship Tournament where she took the most wickets for the entire tournament. At the State Cup Challenge Nikera and her team mates played exceptionally well defeating all 3 rival NSW teams. Unfortunately, the team narrowly lost the Grand Final. Nikera really made the most of this opportunity, representing the district and western zone with absolute distinction.

Junior nominations for the month of *February 2021* were received from:

 Lithgow U14 Boys Swimming Team – Tyler McManus, Nic Waradi, Jacob Wilson and Alex Evans (Swimming) - (4 x50 IM Relay – Mountains & Plains Summer Championship)

The boys relay team won the 4×50 IM relay at the MP Summer Championships winning by 6 seconds. The team also competed in the 4×50 freestyle and came in second place.

- Charlie Evans (Swimming) NSW Country Championships Charlie competed in the U12 200-meter Breaststroke, 10/11 Years 50meter and 100meter Breaststroke. Charlie was a finalist in the 200m breaststroke and won a silver medal in the 50m Breaststroke and Bronze in the 100m Breaststroke.

9. General Business

• David Anderson - Booking of Fields

It was advised that recently there have recently been sporting events occurring on field without bookings or notification of Council. It was also noted that some organisers are placing ads on social media before approval is granted by Council / SAC. This is causing issues with Council and users not have facilities up to standard in terms of maintenance and clean amenities as expected. Administration will be sending a letter to all users to notify of the above and will place ads in the local papers to inform the community.

R Marjoram advised that he recently had a booking at the Wallerawang Stadium for a Basketball Tournament but was cancelled to due floods and teams unable to get through. He informed the committee that he had communication issues in terms of booking the facility prior to the event and had a number of concerns of how the facility is being managed and maintained noting that scoreboard and buzzers were not working. Also noting the dust and large amount of scuff marks on the floor.

L Kearney also advised that there was a push from Lithgow Netball to have the floor resurfaced which was recently completed but also advised that Lithgow Netball have raised these concerns with the Wallerawang Stadium Management Committee on numerous occasions, particularly the scuff marks on the floor.

J Edgecombe advised that a formal letter will be issued to remind the current facility managers of their obligation under the lease and to supply maintenance records.
