The bad: posters were not printed on the day so event was not very visible. Lack of promotion so numbers were disappointing.

For next year: Start planning early.

Ask young people what they want via: school consultation, online survey etc. Criss will present a 30 minute consultation workshop at the next Youth Council meeting to equip the Youth Councillors to consult effectively.

We need a year planner for the event. Increased meetings in the lead up.

Possible idea for next year is a Carnival. Like the Lithgow Show and a pop up

Youth council event at the Show.

We need to make sure there is a connection between the activites so it feels like one big event rather than the disjointed approach this year.

Budget: The budget has not yet been finalised as we are waiting on a couple of invoices. However Ali has spoken with the Youth Week funding body and they are happy for us to use the unspent funds to run a few satelite events over the next 4-6 weeks. The Youth council discussed and agreed to do Saturday morning music events. Small and unplugged in Cook Street Plaza or other venues around town. Ali to organise and inform ASAP.
