Clr J Smith also congratulated the following on their recent selections and achievements:

- Under 14 & Under 18 Boys Basketball Teams for their wins at the NSW Basketball Country Championship, coached by Suzy Morris and Heidi Inwood.
- The men and women who were selected in the Country NSW hockey teams.

The Building and Recreation Facilities Manager advised the committee that Council is working and planning for future programs and upgrades for sporting grounds.

R Smith thanked Council for their assistance with the grounds and set up for the Hockey State Championship to be held this weekend

J Kemp requested if the Paul Houghton Field 1 could be rolled as the ground is slightly uneven in the field due to the recent installation of the irrigation.

L Kearney advised of the following achievements of Lithgow Netball at the Senior State Titles held at Liverpool and Bankstown on the June long weekend:

- Under 17 team won 3 out of 14 games and placed 11th in division 4.
- Under 15 winning 7 out of 14 games and placed 7th in division 4.

L Kearney also advised the committee of her resignation from the Sports Advisory Committee Meeting as she is no longer a representative for the Lithgow Netball Association. The committee noted that the Lithgow Netball Association will advise when a new delegate is selected.
