APPLICATION CONDITIONS

Location details:

- To be eligible for the Alternative Fuel Rebate the property must be zoned residential R1-5 or RU5 with land area ≤ 2 hectares and be within a town or village in the Lithgow Local Government Area.
- Residents in rental properties can apply for incentives provided that the tenant and the property owners agree and both sign the application
- · All coal heaters must be removed and only one cash incentive is available for each premises

Eligible systems:

- To be eligible applicants must submit a completed Application for Alternative Fuel Rebate Form
- The rebate is only available for the replacement of a coal burning appliance
- All coal burning appliances must be removed from the property
- A property is only eligible to one rebate regardless of the number of appliances removed
- Before removal of the appliance Council must inspect the system to determine if it qualifies for the rebate, photos will be taken for Council records.

Installation and disposal:

The replacement heating system must be installed in the same property as the heating system being replaced.

- Replacement of the coal burning appliance <u>must</u> be with an electric, flued gas or alternative approved heating appliance
- A new system can be installed up to 6 months before or after the removal of the coal burning appliance
- Council will inspect & take photos of the replacement system in place prior to the approval of the rebate
- The coal burning appliance must be removed and the receipt of disposal for metal recycling is to be provided by the
 applicant or authorised installer to Council.

Required standards:

Replacement systems must be installed and operated in accordance with relevant Australian Standards, Building Codes, Local Government Requirements and manufacturer's specifications.

Retrospective incentives:

If you have already replaced or are in the process of replacing an eligible coal heater, you are <u>not</u> eligible for a rebate, unless the coal heater/s is still installed.
