TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- All artwork must respond to the impact of the Gospers Mountain Fire 2019 / 2020.
- All Entrants grant permission to the organisers to publish &/or broadcast the names and photographs of the artworks for media and publicity purposes.
- Include a brief description of your artwork, including the inspiration behind the development of the work. (maximum half A4 page)
- Artworks and copyright remain the property of the entrant.

ALL ARTWORK MUST:

- Be safe for public exhibition
- Not exceed a size limit of:
2 dimensional - 2x2 metres
3 dimensional - 1.2m wide x 1.2m deep x 2.4m high
- Not exceed a weight limit of 40kgs
- Be exhibition ready upon delivery. Particular installation requirements must be discussed in advance.

All artwork must be delivered to the Union Theatre (65 Bridge St Lithgow) and artists are responsible for packaging of their own artworks for collection once the exhibition has ended. The cost and means of transport of the artworks are the responsibility of the entrant.

The organisers will take all responsible care in handling and dealing with all works submitted, however the organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage incurred to any artworks or materials.
