

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The Primary School Art Competition 2023 is open from World Environment Day (5 June 2023) and entries must be submitted by Monday, 31 July 2023.
- 2.All entries must be hand drawn on A4 sized paper (no digitally created artworks will be accepted).
- 3.All entries must be original artwork making an exact copy of any pre-existing image is not acceptable, whether visually or by tracing. Colouring in an outline printed or drawn by someone else or having someone else contribute to the artwork is also not acceptable.
- 4. Only one entry per student will be accepted.
- 5. Only one student per entry is permitted, i.e. students cannot submit a joint entry.
- 6. The theme of the competition is 'Let's reduce single-use plastic'.
- 7. Drawings are to be based around environmentally sustainable behaviour. Behaviours that focus on reducing single-use plastic are highly regarded but not essential. Schools may wish to pick a theme that they have focused on in class or provide creative freedom to students in this regard.
- 8. The entry must include the words 'Let's reduce single-use plastic' in the artwork.
- 9. Entries will be judged by Council staff and decisions are final.
- 10.Three prizes will be awarded: Overall Winner; Runner-up; and Encouragement Award (for younger entries)
- 11. Winning prize is to the value of \$50 and the other prizes (two) are \$30 value each.
- 12. Entries can be submitted by scanning or photographing artwork and emailing to

- 14. The winning entries will be selected two weeks after the closing date.
- 15. By entering this competition parents and teachers consent to their children's name and their artworks appearing online and on exhibition.
- 16.Council gains the right to use the winning artworks, which may include, but is not limited to, exhibition, use in the development of signage, social media posts and print materials.
- 17. Council reserves the right to crop and/or correct artwork for hanging or use and to ensure consistency of appearance.
